Proposal: Change in department policy from requiring that all students complete the core requirements of the major with a grade of C or higher before taking any required courses at the 200 level or above to the following:
Before being cleared for graduation, all Electronic Media majors must earn a grade of C or higher in all major (TVR) courses. This requirement must be met for all prerequisites prior to taking advanced courses.
