Sir

I have received & communicated to my Lords
Commis^s. of the Admiralty your Letter of the 12th of September,
acquainting them that you had been cruising off
Santuck's Shoals to intercept any Reinforcements
coming to the Enemy but as the Equinoxials were approaching
you had thought it necessary to return to Gardiner's Island
where you were able to command all the Movements
of Mons^r. Ternay; also giving an account of your having
sent
