Dear PACP Member Association Presidents:

I am enclosing the 2007-2008 PACP Alliance Agreement and Budget for your review and signature. A summary of PACP activities for 2006-2007 is included, as well as a listing of PACP's priorities for 2007-2008.

I appreciated meeting with you and your organization representatives at the PACP Summit in June 2007. It was helpful to get input from all of our member groups and to develop a joint plan for PACP's future. Our direction and commitment are clear. Hopefully membership drives can remove the financial limitations on moving forward.

The enclosed budget is a "bare bones" one. PAMFT has agreed to cover up to a \$2500 shortfall in the budget for this year if the professional counseling groups are unable to contribute beyond their budgeted amounts. As discussed at the Summit, moving forward with a more active legislative effort will require increasing each group's assessment in order to cover the additional costs and our lobbyist's full retainer.

Your organization's assessment is enclosed. Please review this information with your Treasurer for payment. The first quarter assessment is due in October/November.
