*Enter through Edward Leahy Hall, Jefferson Ave entrance (this is the large new building on the corner of Jefferson and Linden that is attached to McGurrin). Use the call box or call my cell to be buzzed in if the doors are not open.

Directions to the University of Scranton

From Pittsburg and points west: Take 22E to 99N to 80E to 81N to exit 185 on left to the Central Scranton Expressway. When the expressway ends, take Lackawanna Avenue for hotels (the Radisson is immediately on your left, and the Hilton will be the first right) or take Jefferson Avenue for McGurrin Hall /Edward Leahy Hall (large buildings on the left).

From Allentown/Philly and points south: Take 476N to exit 115 to 81N and follow directions from there above.

Places to stay

The closest hotels to the University are the Radisson Lackawanna Station (<http://www.radisson.com/scranton-hotel-pa-18503/pascrant>; about \$95-\$125/night depending on how you book) and the Hilton Scranton (<http://www3.hilton.com/en/hotels/pennsylvania/hilton-scranton-and-conference-center-SCRCCHF/index.html>; about \$119-\$149 a night, depending on how you book). Both are one block away from McGurrin Hall. There are several other hotels in the area if you would like to stay somewhere else, including one of the resorts listed below.

Parking

- 1) If you are staying at one of the hotels, you can just leave your car in the hotel lot for the day.
- 2) There is metered parking all around the streets that are close to McGurrin Hall. *You do not need to feed the meters on Saturdays.*
- 3) There are also two faculty lots diagonally across from McGurrin Hall/Edward Leahy Hall that are behind and beside O'Hara hall. You can park there freely on Saturdays (except in the accessible spots unless you have a placard). And finally, there is a campus parking pavilion approximately 1 ½ blocks from McGurrin Hall. On the weekend, you can park in any space unless otherwise marked (i.e., reserved for whomever). Refer to the campus map for locations and proximity to McGurrin Hall.
