C. Information Technology/D2L Updates – M. Freed

D2L

- 2 revisions per year
- upgrades occur during overnight hours and not during the semester
- the decision to upgrade is a PASSHE system decision. 14 schools need to agree on a common day and time – decision was made to have upgrades during Saturday of spring and winter commencements
- archiving policy needed to be implemented because of the large amount of classes stored on the system – courses are retained for a period of three years.

Faculty/Staff e-mail

- Exchange 2007 is being phased out and University is moving to Microsoft Exchange 2013 to allow for more storage – about a gig
- Will take place in phases. One phase will require testing for bugs
